INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA AND IMAGE

According to Art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 Art. 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the GDPR), applicable from May 25, 2018, we inform you that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is Dolnoslaskie Towarzystwo im. F. Chopina in Wrocław, pl. Tadeusza Kosciuszki 10, 50-028 Wrocław, dtifcwroclaw@gmail.com
2. Personal data will be processed on the basis of consent, in accordance with art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a GDPR for the purposes of organization, implementation and participation in the violin competition and for promotional purposes, as well as in accordance with art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR for the purposes of satisfying possible claims of administrators.
3. The recipients of personal data may be:
